Dear customers,

We are aware that the events actually taking place may be a source of concern for you on the proper functioning of your operations. We thought it would be appropriate to inform you of the current situation at Technosub.


Measures are in place to prevent the spread of Covid-19 in our organization. Anyone who has visited foreign countries has the obligation to remain in confinement for a period of 14 days. Those with cold or flu symptoms also have to stay at home. A protocol regarding necessary hygiene practices has been sent to employees and we are also limiting supplier visits to our facilities.

Inventory	So far, our communications with our suppliers do not suggest that we will have short-term supply problems. Technosub currently has the largest pump inventory in Canada. We are able to meet our customers needs for several weeks.
Daily operations at the Rouyn-Noranda plant	So far, our pumps repair, manufacturing and shipping works as usual.
Visits to our customers	All visits outside the country by our engineers and representatives have been postponed. Visits to our Canadian customers will be limited to emergencies and treated on a case-by-case basis.
Canadian branches	All our Canadian branches are currently open and are continuing their operations. Moncton-Boucherville-Sudbury-Timmins-Winnipeg-Saskatoon-Edmonton as well as Surrey. You can contact them as usual.

We cannot predict the next few weeks, however, be assured that Technosub is well positioned to face any challenges that may arise.

We will continue to inform our customers and partners on a regular basis of any changes that may occur in our organization.
